**Library of Congress:** the delegation will have professional meetings at the Library of Congress on July 12. They will receive an overview of the Law Library, meet with the foreign law specialist for China at the Law Library of Congress and have a tour of the Law Library reading room.

**Georgetown University Law Center:** The delegation will receive an overview of the Georgetown University Law Center and its Edward Bennett Williams Law Library. The presentation will include a detailed introduction to the library's collections and services, and a tour of both the library and the Law Center's campus.

**WCL & Pence Law Library:** The delegation will receive an overview of the Pence Law Library and a detailed introduction of its collections and services, meet with the foreign and international law librarians and have a first-hand tour of the award-winning Tenley Campus, a National Register historic site.
